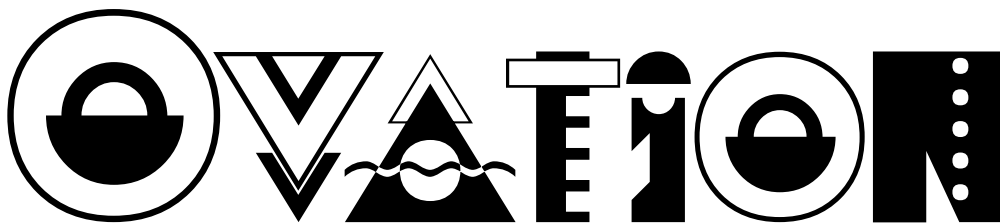

Team Effort Made 2006 Great - 10th Anniversary Best Loveland Art Show Ever!

Saturday, the sky was dark and overcast. A slow, steady rain fell in Nisbet Park. Martin Schickel and I set up the tent for the Starving Artists Café to serve as a shelter from rain or sun, whatever the next day might bring. I silently said a prayer that the booth markers Jeff DeVol and his son had painstakingly measured and marked would not wash away. I heard myself quoting the beautiful postcard designed by Yily, "Event will be held rain or shine." The Loveland Art Show MUST GO ON!

Sure enough, the sun rose gloriously to reveal Sunday's beautiful blue sky and a perfect fall temperature. Pat Furterer arrived with her faithful band of volunteers (Jim Hooper, Rinda Shutts, Dick Lorenz, Deb Harp, Peggy Stouffer, Sharon and Alan Riley, Marsia and Norman Neal, Kathy Lorenz, Doris Osborne, Doug Portmann, Ann and Wayne Barfels, Linda and Bob Cox, Jan and Roger Beller, and Janet Fahrenbach-Lynch, Thank You!) As their portable TVs announced the Bengals score, Paxton's Grill, Seafood Station, the buZZthru, Dessertworks, and Blue Chip Cookie served several hundred made-to-order sandwiches, cups of coffee, cakes and cookies. The countless hours that Kay Bolin spent publicizing and



promoting the Loveland Art Show paid off with another year of high attendance. Families, friends, parents and children, the young and not-so young, Loveland residents, patrons of the Arts, and bike trail enthusiasts, came from near and far to peruse the fine works of painters, jewelry makers, glassblowers, sculptors and photographers.

This years judges, Tom Tsuchiya (sculptor and teacher) and Greg Storer (painter, pastel artist and teacher) devoted several hours to observing and evaluating all of the entries. There were so many entries worthy of awards, they found it difficult to narrow it down to only three winners in each of the four categories. Returning artists expressed their loyalty to the Loveland Art Show, citing the wonderful volunteers and the beautiful park setting as their reasons for coming year after year. 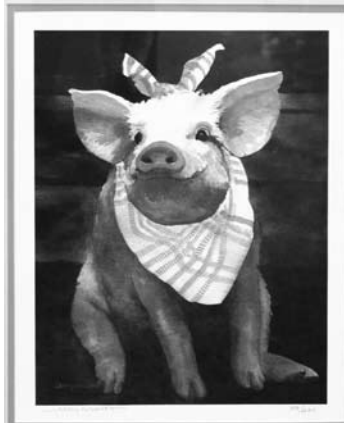
with the community support, the opportunity for so many people to admire their work, and their high volume of sales.
